The round of the ERT FIA Alps and the 1st round of the Swiss Rally Championship 2021 will take place on the roads of the Chablais region of Vaud and Valais. The town of Aigle will be the nerve centre of the Rally.

Thursday 27th May : Friday 28th May:	From 11:00 am to 6:30 pm : Administrative and Technical Scrutiny. 10:15 am : Departure of the First Leg, 4 stages (2 different ones). From 7:30 pm : Arrival of the First Leg.
Saturday 29th May:	7.00 am : Departure of the Second Leg, 8 stages (4 different ones). From 6:55 pm : Final Arrival. 10.30 pm : Presentation of Prizes.
Distance:	Around 156 kilometers of special stages in a total of around 474 kilometres.
Reconnaissance:	Only on 22, 23 and 27 May, as defined in the programme.
Reconnaissance: Registration:	Only on 22, 23 and 27 May, as defined in the programme. Opens 21 April 2021. Closes midnight on Sunday 16 May 2021
