



TER - TOUR EUROPEAN RALLY 2026 REGULATIONS

Art. 1 - DEFINITION AND ORGANIZATION

1.1 - In 2026 the Tour European Rally Promoter will organise a series named TER - Tour European Rally 2026. The series will be governed according to the International Sporting Code (ISC) and its Appendixes, the FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, the National Regulations of the Countries in which the Rallies are held, plus the present regulations.

Art. 2 - EVENTS CALENDAR

2.1 - The events valid for the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally are:

Art. 3 - ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS AND DRIVERS

3.1 - Holders of international licences will be admitted to the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally Series, in accordance with the 2026 International Sporting Licences Regulations.

Holders of national licenses will be admitted with written permission from the driver's ASN.

3.2 - The "TER Junior Championship" will be reserved to drivers under 26 (i.e. born after 01/01/2000) using RC4 R2/Rally4 cars and RC5 Rally5 cars.

3.3 - The TER 2WD Championship will be reserved to drivers using 2 Wheel Drive cars, except for RGT cars.

3.3 - Drivers with 2WD RGT cars will be included in the TER Production/RGT/R4K Trophy classification.

Art. 4 - ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

4.1 - The 2026 TER - Tour European Rally is reserved to vehicles complying with the following standards:

- Vehicles with active homologation or allowed to take part in 2026 national and international rallies (except World Rally Championship) under Article 2.7.1.. c) of the ISC.

Art. 5 - SERIES REGISTRATION AND SCORING REGULATIONS

5.1 - In the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally registration for the Series will be free of charge, it will be possible to register until the posting of the start list of each rally at this link: <https://terseries.com/ter-tour-european-rally-registration-form/>

5.2 - In the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally, there is no minimum number of participants required for any given TER scheduled event.

5.3 - For the final standings, all the results will be considered.

5.4 - In the event of two or more drivers being tied on points at any time during the season, also for the final championship standings,

the driver having set the fastest time in most of the stages will be considered as being the leader.

5.5 - Fuel is free, but must comply with the supplementary regulation of the event.

5.6 - Tyres must comply with FIA Regulations, and the maximum number of tyres allowed will be specified in the supplementary regulations of each event.

Art. 6 - QUALIFYING STAGE

6.1 - The 2026 TER - Tour European Rally events may hold a "Qualifying Stage", followed by the choice of the start positions. This should be preceded by a free practice session on the same stage, with two practice runs allowed per each crew. Organisers who choose to hold a "Qualifying Stage" will specify further details in the event's Supplementary Regulations.

Art. 7 - CLASSIFICATION - SCORES FOR EACH RALLY

7.1 - In each round, the competitors registered for the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally, will score the following points, according to their result in the events' final classification for drivers registered in the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally:
TER Championship - TER Junior Championship - TER 2WD Championship - TER Production/RGT/R4K Trophy - TER Ladies Trophy - TER Codriver Trophy

All the remaining competitors classified from 11th place (included) onwards will also get **1 point**.

7.1.1 - Drivers registered in the TER Junior Championship will not score points in the TER 2WD Championship.

7.1.2 - Drivers registered in the TER Production/RGT/R4K Trophy will not score points in the TER 2WD Championship.

7.2 - In the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally competitors registered for the series will receive additional points in as follows in Overall and in each category classification:

7.2.1 - Each competitor will receive **5 points** at the third start in a 2026 TER - Tour European Rally event, **2 points** at the fourth and **1 point** at each successive event, for a maximum of 6 points, in the overall and category standings.

7.2.2 - If a Driver wins all Special Stages of a Rally in the TER classification, he will receive **7 Additional Points** in the Overall Championship standings.

If the same Driver is also the fastest in all Special Stages in the Rally's overall classification (drivers not registered in TER comprised), the additional points will be **10**.

7.2.3 - If a driver registered for the TER sets the best overall time in 1st Special Stage of a rally (including non-registered competitors), will receive **2 additional bonus points**.

7.2.4 - If a driver registered for the TER sets the best overall time in the final Special Stage of a rally (including non-registered competitors), will receive **2 additional bonus points**.

7.2.5 - In each event of the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally, before the start of the rally, the TER promoter will choose one Special Stage of the rally as the "Power Stage". In this Special Stage the **5 fastest competitors** of the TER (Overall), "TER Junior Championship" and "TER 2WD Championship" will be awarded bonus points for the respective standings:

Art. 8 - CLASSIFICATION OF THE SERIES / CUPS

8.1 - In each event of the 2026 TER - Tour European Rally, a dedicated classification will be published comprising only the competitors registered for the series.

8.2 - If 2 or more crews finish the championship with equal points, the discriminating factors will be as:

- the number of rallies in which the crew took part.
- the placements (in overall or category standings).
- the number of Special Stages won (in overall or category standings).

Art. 9 - FINAL PRIZES

9.1 - The 1st and the 2nd driver of TER overall classification, TER Junior Championship and TER 2WD Championship classification will be awarded the title of 2026 TER champions, 2026 TER Junior Championship champions and 2026 TER 2WD Championship champions.

The 1st and the 2nd driver of TER Production/RGT/R4K Trophy will be awarded the title of 2026 Trophy winners.

The 1st driver of TER Ladies Trophy and TER Codriver Trophy will be awarded the title of 2026 Trophy winners.

Other prizes will be announced soon.
